Creativity, Entrepreneurship, P-TECH & Final Week Preparation

Dear Families, Week 3 of the Summer Bridge Program focused on creativity, entrepreneurship, and continued high school readiness. Students explored art at the Clyfford Still Museum, practiced business skills through YouthBiz and a milkshake sales activity, and continued learning about P-TECH as a pathway into high school, college credit, and career-connected opportunities.

MUSEUM EXPERIENCE: CLYFFORD STILL MUSEUM

Students visited the Clyfford Still Museum in downtown Denver, where they engaged with powerful works of art and practiced observation, reflection, and discussion skills. The experience gave students space to think about creativity, expression, and how art can open up meaningful conversation.

YOUTHBIZ: ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN ACTION

Students continued developing their business ideas through YouthBiz, thinking about how creativity, planning, branding, and communication all connect to entrepreneurship. These activities helped students practice confidence, teamwork, and leadership while building toward their final business presentations.
